Everyday was an exciting day learning the word, hearing bible stories, singing songs, playing sports, art, crafts and other activities. The camp grew each day with additional young people joining.

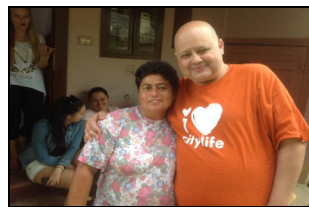
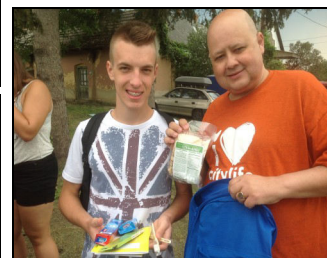
There were delicious meals provided for the students, who would normally go without.

On the last day of the camp Europe's Child Missions provided each camper with a "survival" kit. Each kit included hygiene supplies, vitamins and medicines, school supplies and a food kit. These items were placed in a school back-pack. The kids were delighted to

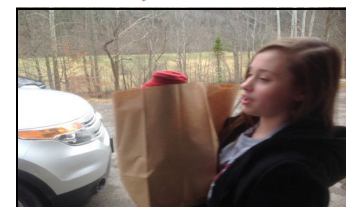

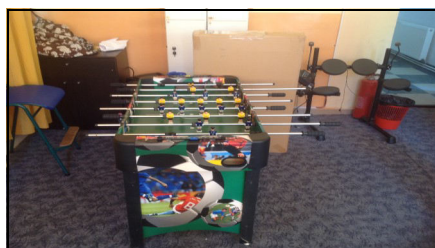

Project Completed: Children of Promise Orphanage

Constanta, Romania

Because of your partners and faithfulness, we were able to supply the center and orphanage with 4 brand new computers; 5 guitars for teaching music; 2 Foosball Tables, and school supplies. Pastor Samuil Mitra and his brother Dan were so grateful for the items we helped with the orphanage.
