Another Record Year with our Youth Camp Ministry

Our summer youth camp ministry is expanding. This year we conducted a total of 9 camps in Hungary, Romania, Poland and Scotland. Here is a brief report from each camp:

Poland, Warsaw—This new camp had a total of 65 people attend. We had 50 Salvations, 2 Baptisms, and a new family to start attending the local church. They were also able to give away 2 TONS of food for those in need.

Scotland—This new camp had a total of 25 attendees and many were touched. The Camp Director reported "Many of our Youth were able to renew their relationship with God and received a touch from the Holy Spirit."

Romania, Constanta— This second year camp had a total of 25 students. This is one of our over-night camps. The camp director reported this, "Tonight we finished off the 'official' time of the camp with a party, as in the Angels having a party in heaven when someone comes to Jesus. It rounded the week off with the subject being 'Looking for treasure '. We asked the children and young people if they wanted Jesus to be their friend and at first 4 girls came forward and as we started praying for them others came, and before we knew it everyone came forward to be prayed for! Many of these children have no church background and it was amazing what God has done this week."

Romania, Pestere—This was one of our new camps this year in a western part of Romania. We took a team from Kentucky and also a team from World Race Missions and developed this brand new camp at Ape Vie Ministries. There were a total of 40 students at the camp. Many of the children and youth re-dedicated their lives to Christ and were filled with the Holy Spirit. Here are thoughts from Missionary Roy Olsen, "What a night! The Holy Spirit moved on the campers AND staff! Tears! Emotion! Responses to God in many ways! Pastor Don R. Chavis, please plan to return to Apa Vie. We believe you are specially gifted and called to this ministry and we want to support you and benefit from Europe's Child Missions!"

Hungary— This year, Pastor Daniel Kriszt conducted 4 camps in the villages of Tiszabecs, Szamosszeg, Tiszabara, and Nyibeltek. Also, Pastor Edgar Kovacs conducted our camp in Uszka. Pastor Daniel sends this report, "We had an amazing time, the children's parents were moved, at Tiszabecs even the mayor came to visit the camp, he just didn't understand how we can do that for free for the children, he saw we even took some from a neighboring town. He also said people in the town were also touched, they never saw that before that anyone would care at all for these poor gypsy children."

Down in the Southeast corner of Romania is a small village located within miles from the Black Sea named Poiana. This village has limited road access in and out surrounded by farmlands. The village only had gravel roads and many times, horse-drawn wagons are widely used methods of transportation. There is no gas station, grocery store, only a small shop to purchase a few necessities until the villagers can get to nearby communities with those conveniences. Alex and Heather Chalmers, A Scottish missionary couple planted themselves in this heavily Turkish populated village several years ago. Europe's Child Missions has partnered with and supported their efforts for the last few years. Recently, we received the news that they are having **extreme financial hardships** in funding the ministry. They are asking for all of their partners for serious prayer for resources to continue. *At the end of the year they will be*

losing approximately \$500 of their current resources. We can offset some of this reduction with your continued partnership.

Meet Pastors Train and Elena Pascalau. They are pastors in Constanta, Romania and dear friends to Europe's Child Missions. For the last 6 years we have partnered to provide ministry in one of the most 'un-churched' cities in Romania. The Pascalau's pastor the Good News Church in a rented auditorium in the City Center Theater. They have faithfully poured their own resources into this church plant. They have a used van that they use for ministry in the Henri Coanda Housing Projects, which houses many Roma gypsies. They also use this van to pick up children and seniors for church and other ministry activities. Recently, their vehicles have had many repair issues. These repair issues have limited their ability to use them for

ministry and thus has hampered the church. *They need around \$700 US Dollars to complete these repairs.* Would you join me in praying that Europe's Child Missions could help take care of this need by Christmas?
