## Another Record Year with our Youth Camp Ministry

# Europe's Child Missions

Our summer youth camp ministry is expanding. This year we conducted a total of 10 camps in Hungary, Romania, Poland and Scotland. Here is a brief report from each camp:

**Poland**, Warsaw—We have received many praise reports from the fields about what God is doing as a result of our ministry. In Poland, Pastor Otek Guzy writes, "The stories I like best are that now after the holidays, children are asking their parents to go to church here in our Octavian church on Sunday." We also managed to organize a Jesus March around Warsaw with our friends, who started from our camp with more than 200 people. We have developed a meeting for the children in our church and started a children's choir."

**Scotland**—This new camp had a total of 35 attendees and many were touched. The Camp Director reported "Many of our Youth were able to renew their relationship with God and received a touch from the Holy Spirit."

**Romania**, Poiana— This second year camp had a total of 40 students. This is one of our over-night camps. Heather Chalmers writes, "Alex is a 10-year-old boy and his parents are abroad working. He is living with his Grandmother and is very much left to his own devices. He has been labeled as a very disruptive boy at school, in the village and when he was with us. At the beginning he was doing everything to disrupt the sessions, but he listened to the stories and all took part in everything and everyday we encouraged him. By the last day we were able to say how well he had been doing during the week." Another little girl named Iulia was very attentive and at the end she said that 'It was the very best day ever in my life'. It brought us to tears and just makes everything worthwhile!"

**Romania**, Pestere—Camp Apa Vie is a camp in the western part of Romania. We took a team from members from across the United States and returned for the second year. There were a total of 105 students at the camp. Many of the children and youth re-dedicated their lives to Christ and were filled with the Holy Spirit. Here are thoughts from Missionary Roy Olsen, "What a week! The Holy Spirit moved on the campers AND staff! Tears! Emotion! Responses to God in many ways! God is up to something in this part of Romania. We are benefactors of the ministry of Europe's Child Missions!" Thank you!

**Hungary**— This year, Pastor Daniel Kriszt conducted 4 camps in the villages of Tiszabecs, Szamosszeg, Szekelyhid, and Uzka. Pastor Daniel sends this report, "We had an amazing time, the children's parents were moved, at Tiszabecs even the mayor came back to visit the camp, he just didn't understand how we can do that for free for the children, he saw we even took some from a neighboring town. He also said people in the town were also touched, they never saw that before that anyone would care at all for these poor gypsy children."
